*大二第二學期成績出來後(暑假了) , 馬上申請正規英文版(Official transcript) , 一份給美國學校(ISSP 會收取)一份自己留檔。

<學姊愛的建議> (仍須視當年度的課程需求自行調整) ←非常重要)

要拿到雙聯學位必須同時滿足彰師大以及美國的畢業門檻 , 下面會詳細說明 , 並提供選課安排

一、彰師大畢業門檻

1. 通識

雖然彰師大的要求是自然*3、人文*3、社會*2 , 但因為美國也有通識要求 , 因此必須修:

古典音樂入門、戲劇中的古典音樂、現代美學+ 自然*3+社會*2

2. 選修

彰師大需要 6 門選修 , 但可用美國的課程可抵三門(BA105w 抵商用英文、MGT110 抵組織行為、COMM3 抵商業簡報技巧) , 因此在台灣只需修財務概論及另外兩門系選修

3. 志工時數 24 小時

4. 通識講座 12 場

5. 離校前一定要到教務處辦理離校手續(小心被退學) , 以及出國選課單。

二、台灣修課建議

1.大一: 大一彰師必修全部都需要選 , 另外可以努力先把通識(為上述第一點)修完

2.大二上: 民法、成本會際、行銷、統計一、管數、國際貿易(企管三)、作業研究(企管三)、財務概論、體育

3.大二下: 管理會計、普通生物、環境災害(或是普通化學、普通物理)、國際財務管理(企管三)、體育

4. 如果上述的課真的無法全部修到也不用著急，可以在美國補修相似的課程，但一定要先問好系辦、科任老師、或是通識中心，確定可以抵讓彰師的課程並留有證明；美國每學期以 19 學分為上限 (線上選課 16 學分+開學跑加簽 3 學分)，請自行排課表斟酌

三、美國修課建議

1. 到美國後會有 6 大領域可以選擇，行銷、管理、創業等等，管理是最能夠在兩年內順利修習完畢的領域，因此下面的課程安排以管理為例

2. 到美國後第二學期前報名 EPT(English Placement Test)。即使沒考過門檻也無須緊張，因為你會修 English 10 (留學分生必修)。但所有拿學位的留學生都須要考試

3. GE 為通識課程，IB、IC、ID 三領域各需要選一門(如附圖一)

1999-2000 TO PRESENT GENERAL EDUCATION (G.E.) REQUIREMENTS

NOTES: A minimum of 51 G.E. units are required. All classes are three or more semester units.
Engineering and Liberal Studies majors complete a different G.E. pattern--consult department advisor.

◆ FOUNDATION

Four courses: One in A1, one in A2, one in A3, & one in B4 for a minimum of 12 units.
FOUNDATION courses must be satisfied with a minimum "C" grade.

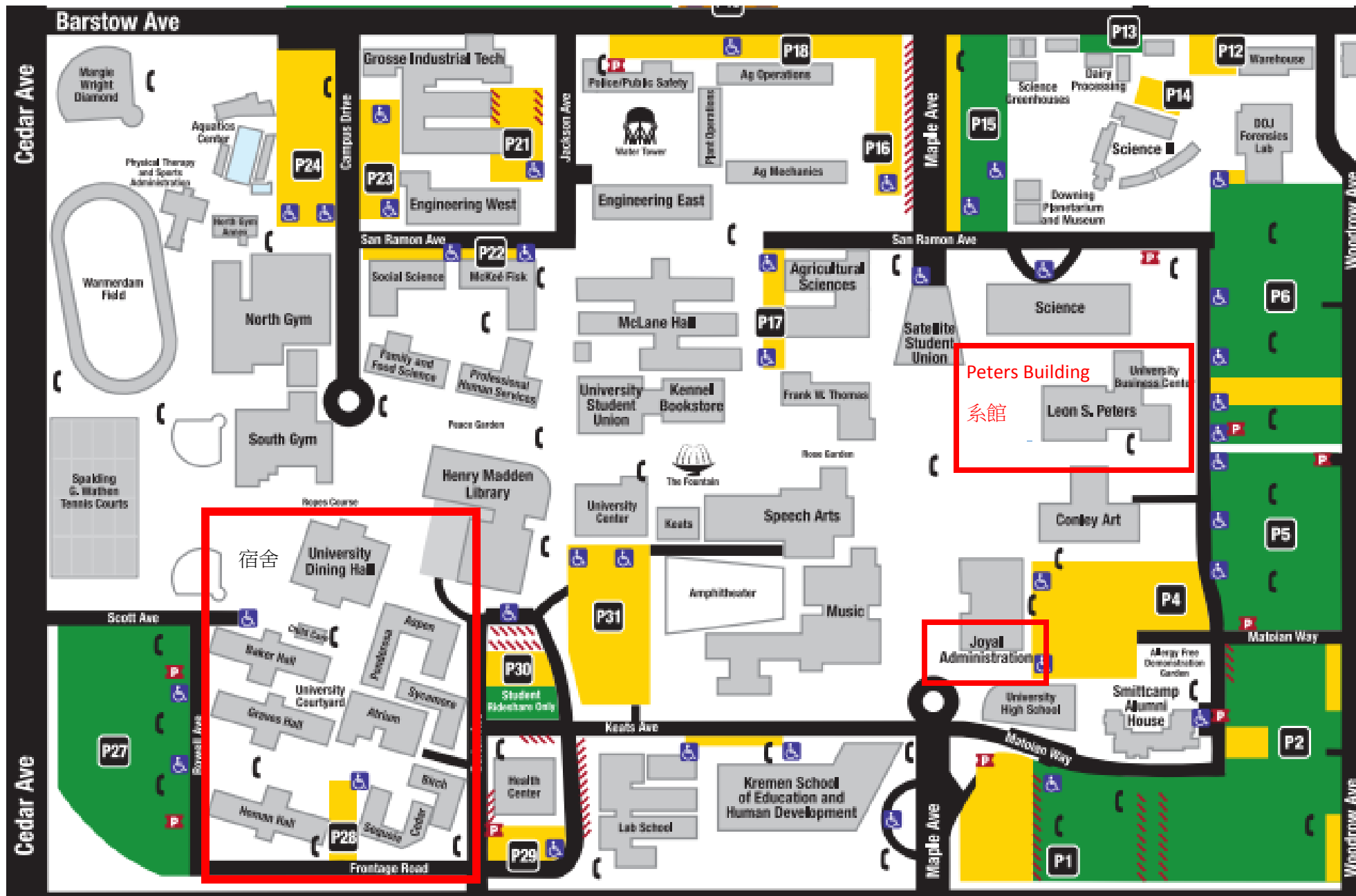
